

Safety Meeting Minutes 3-4-2022

Old Business:

- Hotsy Pressure washer - Hotsy came out and cleaned the unit. Yesterday Mike B. smelled fumes, and Mark H contacted Hotsy to send someone out. In the meantime, John suggested Mike get with Phil to see if we still have a CO monitor to make sure the CO levels are reasonable.
- Yak Traxs – everyone who wants them has them

New Business:

- Mask Mandates – is set to expire on March 18, 2022. As of right now, there is no word on if there will be another extension. Once an update comes out, we will inform staff and the drivers.
- Defibrillator and Fire Safety - April Staff meeting will cover this training and Tornado safety.
- Spring CPR classes. Mark and Daurine will set these up. If room, let staff know this class is available for them to take.
- Driver Accidents
 - Driver – hit a parked car as he was turning – Mark L has talked to him, as the accident was due to unsafe behavior, he will lose his incentive pay
 - Driver – back up into a parked car - Mark L has talked to him, as the accident was due to unsafe behavior, he will lose his incentive pay
 - Driver – Accident on December 30, 2021. We need more information before determining if he will lose his incentive pay for this.
- Work Comp –
 - Driver- Reports an injury a week after the incident. He told Daurine P he did not know about the Company Nurse. For this six-month driver training, drivers are to watch a Company Nurse video in NeoGov.
- While looking at the bus video in connection to the work comp claim, John observed several issues
 - Tiedowns left on the floor when not in use, causing a tripping hazard for riders
 - Wheelchairs not secured correctly
 - Non-SWIPCO people running lift controls
 - The client requested to bring walker up on the lift, and the driver told them to carry it up the stairs.
