Discussed that Mike will discuss with the taxi drivers if they would prefer to use a headset or earpiece that is blue toothed to their phones while driving instead of picking up the phone while driving. No driver should be writing down addresses while driving, they should pull over or write addresses down at the next stop. John, Chris, and Mike will get this information along with other information about the importance of bucking up clients in a wheelchair communicated to the ALL the drivers.
